

MEDICAL ONCOLOGY - HEAD AND NECK TELEMEDICINE QUICK REFERENCE PROTOCOL

PURPOSE

Head and Neck Telemedicine appointments are available for patients who finished treatment and require a standard 3-6 months follow-up visit.

CLINIC AVAILABILITY AND REFFERAL PROCESS

- Patient's eligibility will be determined by the Dr. M. Chasen.
- Appointments are available Monday through Friday as per normal Clinic schedule and are subject to change as per physician's availability.
- All appointments are booked for 15 minutes unless instructed otherwise.

SCHEDULING PROCESS

Once confirmation received from TOH Telemedicine Staff of appointment booked, <u>The Patient Site Nurse will:</u>

- Contact patient to confirm appointment time, duration, location and directions to their Telemedicine site.
- Mark 'patient notified' in Ncompass
- Patient must arrive 30 min prior to appointment start time in order to fill out appropriate paperwork.

- Edmonton Symptom Assessment Scale (ESAS)
- Palliative Performance Scale Function Assessment
- Brief Pain Inventory (BPI)
- Distress Thermometer Form
- PG-SGA Nutrition Form
- Standard Telemedicine Worksheet (includes VS, med list, allergies, height, weight)
