

Shaping the future of health care at the Shirley E. Greenberg Women's Health Centre



In a Canadian first, Dr. Sony Singh used a **3D-printed model** to plan a complex surgery that removed more than 50 fibroids but left the uterus intact, protecting the patient's ability to carry a baby.

A **new 3D ultrasound** machine has expanded our women's health research capabilities and reduced wait times for a pelvic ultrasound from four months to two weeks.

We are one of just a handful of Canadian sites chosen to participate in **two, large multi-national studies** to assess new pharmaceutical treatments for endometriosis pain. *ClinicalTrials.gov NCT03573336 and NCT03213457*

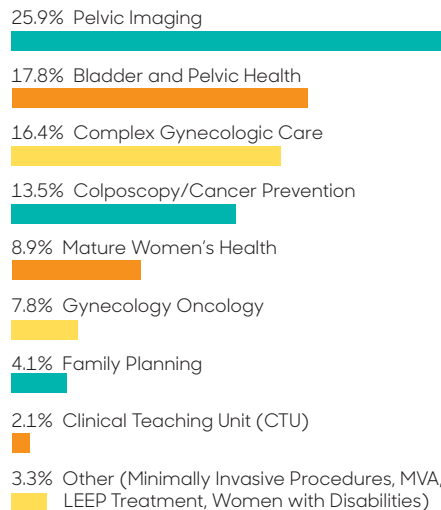

Our Outpatient Management of Early Pregnancy Loss (OPEL) program is unique in Canada and provides rapid access to surgical management for women experiencing an early pregnancy loss (EPL).

OPEL addresses emotional and medical needs, reduces the need for general anesthesia and time in the operating room, and has improved the patient experience. OPEL has been presented at provincial and national meetings and has earned the TOH Team Award for Patient Experience.
