

## My Check List Regarding My Appointment Medical Imaging Department

Questions I want to ask about my procedure. (Use this space to write down questions so you don't forget to ask).
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Get involved about your procedure.
Ask questions or concerns you may have about your care.
Remember to tell the staff of any past illnesses and your current health.
<ul> <li>If the instructions for your procedure ask that you bring in your medication, please bring them in their original bottles with you.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Tell the staff if you have had an allergic or bad reaction to any medication, food or contrast (dye used in radiology procedures).</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Read carefully any instructions on preparation requirements for your procedure.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Make sure you know what to do after you leave the hospital.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>If you have an Ottawa Hospital green card, please ensure you bring this with you.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Make sure you let the staff know if you are pregnant or may be pregnant.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Before your procedure, ask staff if they have washed their hands or used the alcohol gel/foam.</li> </ul>
The following check list is to help you understand the procedure you are having and what if any, special instructions after your procedure are expected. This is for you to keep and bring with you.
I understand the procedure that will be performed today.
I know the instructions I have been given regarding my medication(s).
My questions have been answered to my satisfaction.
I understand the information and instructions I have been given.
I know what to do in case there are complication(s) after my procedure.

Remember to wash your hands before you leave the hospital.

I know if I need further tests and how they will be booked.
